A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Georgia Peanut Festival; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, since 1964, the Georgia Peanut Festival has shown the world how much can be
3 accomplished through civic pride and the spirit of community cooperation; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the festival began as a collaborative effort of the Worth County Chamber of
5 Commerce, the Worth County Band Boosters, and several local civic organizations, with
6 stacks of peanuts being placed on the sidewalks of downtown Sylvester, Georgia; and
- 7 WHEREAS, from these humble beginnings, the festival has been transformed over the years
8 into a gala consisting of a parade, craft shows, beauty contests, and many other activities for
9 people of all ages; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Georgia Peanut Festival, to be held this year on October 21, 2006, draws
11 thousands of revelers to Worth County each year and has a tremendous impact on the
12 economic growth of the community; and
- 13 WHEREAS, an event on the scale of the Georgia Peanut Festival is made possible only
14 through the extraordinary dedication of its leaders and the total cooperation of the entire
15 community, and the good citizens of Worth County have met these demands year after year
16 to produce one of the most exciting events in Georgia.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 the members of this body commend the Georgia Peanut Festival as an outstanding annual
19 event that reflects so well on the spirit of the community.
