A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Honorable Bill Cummings; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Honorable Bill Cummings has served with unparalleled ability as a member of
3 the House of Representatives since 1981; and

4 WHEREAS, this dynamic and powerful public servant has faithfully represented the citizens
5 of Bartow, Floyd and Polk counties with great distinction, dedication, and ability; and

6 WHEREAS, his consistently thorough consideration of the issues presented to the General
7 Assembly and his integrity and reliability have rightfully earned him the honor, respect, and
8 trust of his colleagues over the years and were properly reflected in his committee
9 responsibilities which include his current service as a member of the House Committee on
