### A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Mr. Raymond Floyd; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Mr. Raymond Floyd is widely recognized as a gentleman golfer, a dedicated  
3 family man, and a servant to his community; and

4 WHEREAS, his prestigious achievements in the game of golf include winning 62 events  
5 worldwide, including one Masters, one U.S. Open Championship, and two PGA  
6 Championships, with his official winnings topping \$17 million; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Floyd has represented the United States in eight Ryder Cup Tournaments,  
8 in one of which he served as captain; and

9 WHEREAS, he joined the legendary Sam Snead in becoming the only player to ever win a  
10 tournament in each of four decades on the professional tour; and

11 WHEREAS, he is the only player to ever win on the PGA Tour and the PGA Senior Tour in  
12 the same year; and

13 WHEREAS, his devotion to family resulted in the Floyd family being named "Golf's Family  
14 of the Year" in 1994; and

15 WHEREAS, an inspiration to all who love the game of golf, it is abundantly fitting and  
16 proper that the extraordinary accomplishments of this great man are recognized by this body.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
18 commend Mr. Raymond Floyd on his contributions to the game of golf, on his public service,  
19 and on being such an excellent role model and extend to him their best wishes for future  
20 health and happiness.
