16 overseas, in addition to bringing much needed supplies to injured veterans recuperating at
17 the VA Hospital in Augusta; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Mrs. Adams is survived by a loving and devoted family, including her husband,
19 Hoyt Adams, her brother, Charles Mossburg, two nieces, and one nephew; and
- 20 WHEREAS, a devout Baptist, Mrs. Adams devoted her whole being to helping others, and
21 she will always be remembered with great love by all who had the privilege to know this
22 exceptional lady; and
