- and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he earned 37 merit badges, exceeding the 21 merit badges that were required
- 13 to attain Eagle, and for his Eagle Scout service project, he organized and completed a
- 14 landscaping project at the new Tunnel Hill Heritage Center; and
- 15 WHEREAS, it is especially fitting and proper for this body to recognize the outstanding
- 16 accomplishments of this extraordinary young man.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 18 commend Jonathan G. Daniel Albertson for his diligence and dedication and congratulate
- 19 him on attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
