A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Jonathan G. Daniel Albertson on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Jonathan G. Daniel Albertson, of Boy Scout Troop 75 in Dalton, Georgia, has
4 earned the rank of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of
5 America, which will be awarded to him at an Eagle Court of Honor on July 29, 2006; and

6 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle has been the symbol of the highest achievement among
7 the Boy Scouts of America, with only one scout out of 97 ever reaching this lofty level of
8 achievement; and

9 WHEREAS, a candidate for this most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
10 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
11 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and

12 WHEREAS, he earned 37 merit badges, exceeding the 21 merit badges that were required
13 to attain Eagle, and for his Eagle Scout service project, he organized and completed a
14 landscaping project at the new Tunnel Hill Heritage Center; and

15 WHEREAS, it is especially fitting and proper for this body to recognize the outstanding
16 accomplishments of this extraordinary young man.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 commend Jonathan G. Daniel Albertson for his diligence and dedication and congratulate
19 him on attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
