- 1 Commending the Henry W. Grady High School Class of 1956; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Henry W. Grady High School Class of 1956 will hold its 50th graduation
- 3 anniversary reunion this year; and
- 4 WHEREAS, when Henry W. Grady High School opened in 1924, it was one of two high
- 5 schools in Atlanta, Georgia, and since that time it has been named a Georgia School of
- 6 Excellence, one of "America's Best Schools" by *Redbook*, and the Best of Atlanta by *Atlanta*
- 7 Magazine; and
- 8 WHEREAS, in 1947, the complexion of the school changed and it became a co-educational,
- 9 neighborhood school named for Henry W. Grady, a well-known orator and writer who was
- 10 editor of *The Atlanta Constitution*; and
- 11 WHEREAS, in the cafeteria is a mural depicting the merger of Girls High and Boys High in
- 12 an idyllic panorama of boys and girls mingling in Piedmont Park reflecting the new Henry
- 13 W. Grady High School emerged from a faculty drawn from both Boys and Girls High, which
- serves as a reminder of the excitement and spirit of creativity that was felt in the 1950's when
- 15 Atlanta Public Schools were first made co-educational; and
