A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Bryan Drawdy on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Bryan Drawdy, a member of Boy Scout Troop 321, has earned the rank of
3 Eagle Scout; and
- 4 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle Scout Award has been the symbol of the highest and most
5 prestigious achievement among the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Bryan Drawdy has joined the elite ranks of the top 4 percent of scouts who
7 achieve the rank of Eagle Scout; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the candidate for the rank of Eagle Scout must complete a rigorous program of
9 training and must demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques and
10 commitment to the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the attainment of this rank indicates that a scout has developed leadership
12 ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities that will be
13 of immense benefit throughout his life; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Bryan Drawdy's Eagle Scout Service Project involved organizing, developing,
15 and leading a large service project in his community consisting of building benches for Reed
16 Bingham State Park; and
- 17 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Bryan Drawdy has brought honor to himself,
18 his family, and his troop.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that Bryan Drawdy is
20 recognized and commended on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout and he is extended best
21 wishes for success and happiness in future endeavors.
