## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Honorable Alberta J. Anderson; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the citizens of House District 123 are very fortunate to have the extraordinary  
3 service of one of the House of Representatives's most respected members, Honorable  
4 Alberta J. Anderson; and
- 5 WHEREAS, a native of Burke County, Georgia, Representative Anderson graduated from  
6 Waynesboro High School in Waynesboro, Georgia, and attended Seattle University in  
7 Seattle, Washington, and Savannah State College; and
- 8 WHEREAS, she first entered politics in 1993, when she was elected to serve on the  
9 Waynesboro City Council, and was elected to her current office in 1995 after she

13 House Committee on Agriculture and Consumer Affairs, the House Committee on Banks and  
14 Banking, and the House Committee on Education; and
- 15 WHEREAS, outside of her legislative duties, Representative Anderson is an adult career  
16 advisor for the Richmond/Burke Job Training Authority in Augusta, Georgia; and
- 17 WHEREAS, a tireless champion of the mistreated and forgotten, Representative Anderson  
18 is widely admired by all her colleagues for her integrity, vision, and devotion to serving her  
19 constituents and all of the people of Georgia; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Representative Anderson has now decided to retire from her service in the  
21 House of Representatives, where her outstanding leadership will be greatly missed.
