- 2 WHEREAS, Jordan Sanderson of Boy Scout Troop 650 of the Atlanta Area Council has
3 earned the rank of Eagle Scout; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for this most exceptional award in scouting must earn 21 merit
5 badges, 12 of which are mandatory for the Eagle Scout program; and
- 6 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and
7 Jordan Sanderson has ably demonstrated his aptitude and competency in mastering the many
8 special skills taught through the Boy Scout program; and
- 9 WHEREAS, for his Eagle Scout service project, Jordan Sanderson built a flagstone walkway
10 and a wooden bridge for the Autry Mill Nature Center in Fulton County, a project that
11 required over 250 Boy Scout volunteer hours over a six-week period; and

13 of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner becoming of an
14 Eagle Scout; and

17 outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary young man.
