

**ADOPTED SENATE**

1 Senators Wiles of the 37th, Shafer of the 48th and Pearson of the 51st offered the following  
2 amendment:

3 *Amend the Senate committee substitute to HB 1097 by striking line 1 of page 1 and inserting*  
4 *in lieu thereof the following:*

5 To amend Code Section 21-2-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
6 prohibited placements of campaign posters, signs, and advertisements, so as to limit certain  
7 regulations of campaign signs on private property; to amend Article 3 of Chapter 6 of Title  
8 32 of the of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,

9 By redesignating Sections 1 through 8 as Sections 2 through 9, respectively.

10 *By inserting between lines 12 and 13 of page 1 the following:*

11 **SECTION 1.**

12 Code Section 21-2-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to prohibited  
13 placements of campaign posters, signs, and advertisements, is amended by striking  
14 subsection (a) and inserting a new subsection (a) to read as follows:

15 "(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to place ~~campaign~~ posters, signs, and or  
16 advertisements:

17 ~~(1) Within the right of way of any public streets, roads, or highways;~~

18 ~~(2)~~(1) On any public property or building, unless the owner thereof or the occupier as  
19 authorized by such owner has given permission to place such posters, signs, or  
20 advertisements on such property; provided, however, that signs within the rights of way  
21 of public roads shall be governed by Code Section 32-6-51;

22 ~~(3)~~(2) On any private property unless the owner thereof or the occupier as authorized by  
23 such owner has given permission to place such ~~campaign~~ posters, signs, and or  
24 advertisements on such property; and, provided, further that no municipal, county, or  
25 consolidated government may restrict by regulation or other means the length of time a  
26 political campaign sign may be displayed or the number of signs which may be displayed  
27 on private property for which permission has been granted; or

29 ~~(5)~~(3) On any property zoned for commercial or industrial uses if the placement of such  
30 ~~campaign~~ posters, signs, and or advertisements conflicts with any zoning laws or  
31 ordinances."
