## A RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, in her over three decades as a part of the education profession, Ms. Sue Morris,  
3 Superintendent of Buford City Schools, has touched the lives of countless students with her  
4 inspiring leadership and undying passion for learning; and

5 WHEREAS, Ms. Morris holds a Bachelor of Science in business education from Athens  
6 College in Alabama, a Master of Education in middle grades from Brenau University, and  
7 an educational specialist degree in educational leadership from the University of Georgia;

10 1973 and spent the next several years teaching there and at Buford Elementary School; and

13 School; and

15 also served as principal of Buford Elementary School and Buford Academy before she  
16 became her school system's superintendent in 2001; and

17 WHEREAS, throughout her many years as a teacher and administrator, Ms. Morris has  
18 earned the immense respect of her students, colleagues, and parents and has received  
19 numerous accolades, including being named the School System Teacher of the Year in 1981;

2 abundantly fitting and proper for this body to pay tribute to her many invaluable  
3 contributions to education on the occasion of this important milestone.
