A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring and expressing appreciation to Reverend Matthew Hill on this occasion of his
2 retirement as Sergeant at Arms and Doorkeeper for the Georgia State Senate; and for other
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, Reverend Matthew D. Hill was first elected to the position of Sergeant at Arms
5 for the Georgia Senate in 1998 and has served without fail for nine consecutive terms; and

6 WHEREAS, Reverend Matthew Hill has served honorably as Sergeant at Arms for the
7 Senate with great ability, courtesy, and dedication, and his gentlemanly manner has greatly
8 endeared him to all the members of this body; and

9 WHEREAS, his commitment to helping others, his community, and the citizens of Georgia

19 assembly, and a friend to many and he will be greatly missed.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
21 hereby express to Reverend Matthew D. Hill their deep and abiding appreciation for his
22 many years of effective and dedicated service and the kindness he has shown to all that
23 entered the Senate doors; convey to him their heartiest congratulations upon the occasion of

1 his retirement; and extend to him their most sincere best wishes for his continued health and
2 happiness.
