A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 32 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 living wills, so as to revise the statutory living will form; to provide for related matters; to
3 provide for an effective date and applicability; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
4 purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Chapter 32 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to living wills, is
8 amended by striking subsection (b) of Code Section 31-32-3, relating to execution of living
9 wills, witnesses, and forms; and inserting in its place the following:

10 "(b) The declaration shall be a document, separate and self-contained. Any declaration
11 which constitutes an expression of the declarant's intent shall be honored, regardless of the
12 form used or when executed. Declarations executed on or after March 28, 1986, shall be
13 valid indefinitely unless revoked. A declaration similar to the following form or in
14 substantially the form specified under prior law shall be presumed on its face to be valid
15 and effective:

16 **LIVING WILL**

19 known my desire that my life shall not be prolonged under the circumstances set forth

14 I direct ~~that~~ the application of the following life-sustaining procedures to my body and
15 that I be permitted to die (check the my initials indicate the option desired):

16 (A) I will receive no nourishment or fluids including ~~nourishment and hydration,~~

27 2. In the absence of my ability to give directions regarding the use of such
28 life-sustaining procedures, it is my intention that this living will shall be honored by my
29 family and physician(s) as the final expression of my legal right to refuse medical or
30 surgical treatment and accept the consequences from such refusal;

31 3. I understand that I may revoke this living will at any time;

32 4. I understand the full import of this living will, and I am at least 18 years of age and
33 am emotionally and mentally competent to make this living will; and

1 5. If I am a female and I have been diagnosed as pregnant, this living will shall have
2 no force and effect unless the fetus is not viable and I indicate by initialing after this
3 sentence that I want this living will to be carried out. _____(Initial)

6 I hereby witness this living will and attest that:

7 (1) The declarant is personally known to me and I believe the declarant to be at least
8 18 years of age and of sound mind;

9 (2) I am at least 18 years of age;

10 (3) To the best of my knowledge, at the time of the execution of this living will, I:

11 (A) Am not related to the declarant by blood or marriage;

12 (B) Would not be entitled to any portion of the declarant’s estate by any will or by
13 operation of law under the rules of descent and distribution of this state;

14 (C) Am not the attending physician of declarant or an employee of the attending
15 physician or an employee of the hospital or skilled nursing facility in which declarant
16 is a patient;

17 (D) Am not directly financially responsible for the declarant’s medical care; and

18 (E) Have no present claim against any portion of the estate of the declarant;

19 (4) Declarant has signed this document in my presence as above instructed, on the
20 date above first shown.

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SECTION 2.

This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2006. Any declaration which is in essence a living will, using the form specified in Code Section 31-32-3 as amended by this Act or a form specified under prior provisions of such Code section, shall continue to be valid and effective on and after July 1, 2006.

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SECTION 3.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
