A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring Mr. Vivian Deen; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, on November 22, 2005, former Sergeant Vivian Deen finally received the
- 3 recognition he deserved for his distinguished service in the United States Army over 60 years
- 4 ago; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Mr. Deen served with the 503rd Parachute Infantry Regimental Combat Team
- 6 during World War II, performing his first combat parachute jump on September 5, 1943, in
- 7 Markham Valley, New Guinea, in what was the first combat drop in the Pacific; he had his
- 8 second combat parachute jump on July 3, 1944, on Noemfoor Island; and
- 9 WHEREAS, his third combat mission was a parachute jump on Corregidor Island, one of the
- 10 most overlooked battlefields of World War II, in 1945; in 1963, the Republic of the
- 11 Philippines and the United States turned this area into a battlefield park as a World War II
- 12 memorial; and
- 13 WHEREAS, on his fourth combat mission, on Negros Island, Mr. Deen was twice wounded,
- 14 first by being shot by a sniper and then again when the ambulance that was transporting him
- 15 to the field hospital hit a mine; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Mr. Deen was honorably discharged on October 29, 1945; and
- 17 WHEREAS, among the prestigious decorations Mr. Deen received at his recent ceremony
- 18 were the Bronze Star, the Purple Heart with First Oak Leaf Cluster, the Army Good Conduct
- 19 Medal, the American Campaign Medal, the Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Medal with four
- 20 Bronze Service Stars and Bronze Arrowhead, the World War II Peace Medal, the United
- 21 States Presidential Unit Citation Ribbon, the Philippine Presidential Unit Citation Ribbon,
- 22 the Honorable Service Lapel Button, the Parachutist Badge, and the Cold War Recognition
- 23 Certificate; and

1 WHEREAS, his accomplishments have been entered into the *Congressional Record*; and

- 2 WHEREAS, Mr. Deen's valiant service and sacrifice on behalf of this country helped to
- 3 make this world a more free and secure place for generations to come, and it is abundantly
- 4 fitting and proper for this body to recognize such an extraordinary American hero.

- 6 the members of this body join in honoring Mr. Vivian Deen on his brave and noble service

- 8 and recognize this outstanding Georgian on the occasion of his receiving his well-deserved
- 9 decorations from the United States Army.
