10 Instruction and Staff Development; and

14 for her passion for learning, her devotion to classroom excellence, and her constant
15 willingness to go above and beyond the call of duty to serve the needs of each and every one

18 her promotion and support for gifted education and her overseeing the system's replacement
19 of the former Georgia curriculum with the new Georgia Performance Standards; and

21 lives of countless young people and have earned her numerous prestigious honors, along with
22 the immense respect and admiration of colleagues, students, and parents; and

2 educators, Dr. Jackson has decided to retire, and it is abundantly fitting and proper for this
3 body to pay tribute to this extraordinary professional's many accomplishments on the
4 occasion of this very special milestone.
