- 1 Celebrating the life of Charles S. (Buddy) Cowan, Jr., and dedicating the Charles S. (Buddy)
- 2 Cowan, Jr. Memorial Bridge; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Charles Cowan was a native son of Georgia, born on February 10, 1923, in
- 4 Baldwin County, Georgia; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Buddy Cowan served honorably in the United States Armed Forces from
- 6 January 1943 until November 1946, including two years of service in the South Pacific; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Charles Cowan began employment with the State Highway Department of
- 8 Georgia on March 1, 1948, and continued his career with the Georgia Department of
- 9 Transportation until his retirement on August 1, 1977; and
- 10 WHEREAS, during his career, Charles Cowan worked on and supervised the construction
- of many road projects in Baldwin and other counties; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Charles Cowan was the Project Engineer when the State Route 22 bridge over
- 13 Watson Creek was constructed; and
- 14 WHEREAS, said bridge is located only a few hundred feet from the home he shared with his
- wife and three children; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost a distinguished citizen with the passing of Charles S.
- 17 (Buddy) Cowan, Jr., on March 20, 2001; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Charles Cowan is survived by his wife, Geraldine Lynch Cowan; his son,
- 19 Ronald C. Cowan; and his two daughters, Diane C. Mahlberg and Faye C. Bowen; and

1 WHEREAS, it is only fitting that a man who did so much to improve the highway system in

- 2 Georgia and Baldwin County have a bridge named in his honor.
- 3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 4 GEORGIA that the bridge on SR 22 where it crosses Watson Creek in Baldwin County is
- 5 dedicated as the Charles S. (Buddy) Cowan, Jr. Memorial Bridge.
- 6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
- 7 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such bridge.
- 8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 9 to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to Mrs. Geraldine Cowan, to the Baldwin
- 10 County Commission, and to the Department of Transportation.
