

House Bill 1642 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To provide that the chief magistrate of Webster County shall have the authority to appoint
2 a person other than the clerk of the superior court to serve as clerk of the Magistrate Court
3 of Webster County; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

6 Any other provision of law to the contrary notwithstanding, the chief magistrate of Webster
7 County shall have the authority to appoint a person other than the clerk of the superior court
8 to serve as clerk of the Magistrate Court of Webster County.

9 SECTION 2.

10 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
