#### A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and service of Sergeant Jonathon Christopher Haggin and offering  
2 condolences to his family upon his recent loss in combat; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Sergeant Jonathon Christopher Haggin of St. Mary's, Georgia, was a member  
4 of the 48th Infantry Brigade of the Georgia Army National Guard serving in Iraq; and

5 WHEREAS, this courageous soldier confronted the dangers, privations, and discomforts of  
6 striving to keep the peace in Iraq with fortitude and steadfast resolve, making us as a nation  
7 truly proud; and

8 WHEREAS, Sergeant Haggin was killed in action on July 30, 2005, while serving in Iraq;

10 WHEREAS, Sergeant Haggin selflessly gave his life in the service and defense of his  
11 country, and his heroism will never be forgotten; and

12 WHEREAS, his grieving family and friends can be proud of their loved one and, through  
13 their grief, know that he gave his all for his country; and

14 WHEREAS, all Americans owe a debt of gratitude to the men and women of our armed  
15 forces who risk their lives in defending freedom and securing the blessings of liberty for this  
16 nation and other peoples of the world.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
18 honor Sergeant Jonathon Christopher Haggin for making the ultimate sacrifice in his  
19 courageous and dedicated service to our nation and the most sincere condolences are offered  
20 to his family and loved ones.
