Code Section 50-3-100 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to English designated as the official language, constitutional rights not denied, authorization for documents and forms in other languages, and exceptions, is amended by revising subsection (c) as follows:

"(c) State agencies, counties, municipal corporations, and political subdivisions of this state are <u>not</u> authorized to use or to print official documents and forms in languages any <u>language</u> other than the official language, at the discretion of their governing authorities. Documents filed or recorded with a state agency or with the clerk of a county, municipal corporation, or political subdivision must be in the official language or, if the original document is in a language other than the official language, an English translation of the document must be simultaneously filed."
