A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Chapter 5 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to ethics
2	in government, so as to enact the "Fair Campaign Practices Act"; to provide a short title; to
3	provide a statement of legislative intent; to provide a Code of Fair Campaign Practices; to
4	provide that every candidate for public office shall receive a blank form of such code; to
5	provide for the printing of such forms; to provide for the filing of such forms; to provide that
6	subscription of such code shall be voluntary; to provide for indications of filing on political
7	advertising; to provide for statutory construction; to provide for related matters; to repeal
8	conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
10	SECTION 1.
11	Chapter 5 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to ethics in
12	government, is amended by inserting at the end thereof the following:

(a) When a candidate for public office in this state files a notice of candidacy or is
nominated for public office, the Secretary of State is directed to ensure that the candidate
receives a blank form of the Code of Fair Campaign Practices as set out in Code Section
21-5-93 and a copy of this article.

(b) The Secretary of State shall ensure that each candidate is informed that the candidate
may subscribe to and file the code with the Secretary of State and that subscription to the
code is voluntary.

- 10 The text of the Code of Fair Campaign Practices shall read as follows:

'Code of Fair Campaign Practices

12 There are basic principles of decency, honesty, and fair play which every candidate for 13 public office in the State of Georgia has a moral obligation to observe and uphold in order 14 that after vigorously contested, but fairly conducted, campaigns our citizens may exercise 15 their constitutional right to a free and untrammeled choice and the will of the people may 16 be fully and clearly expressed on the issues.

17 THEREFORE:

- (1) I shall conduct my campaign openly and publicly and limit attacks on my opponent
 to legitimate challenges to my opponent's record and stated positions on issues.
- 20 (2) I shall not use or permit the use of character defamation, whispering campaigns, libel,
- 21 slander, or scurrilous attacks on any candidate or his or her personal or family life.
- (3) I shall not use or permit any appeal to negative prejudice based on race, sex, religion,
 or national origin.
- (4) I shall not use campaign material of any sort that misrepresents, distorts, or otherwise
 falsifies the facts, nor shall I use malicious or unfounded accusations that aim at creating
 or exploiting doubts, without justification, as to the personal integrity or patriotism of my
 opponent.
- (5) I shall not undertake or condone any dishonest or unethical practice that tends to
 corrupt or undermine our system of free elections or that hampers or prevents the full and
 free expression of the will of the voters, including any activity aimed at intimidating
 voters or discouraging them from voting.

2	participation in the electoral process and shall not engage in any activity aimed at
3	intimidating voters or discouraging them from voting.
4	(7) I shall immediately and publicly repudiate others' methods and tactics that I have
5	pledged not to use or condone. I shall take firm action against any subordinate who
6	violates any provision of this code or the laws governing elections.
7	I, the undersigned, candidate for election to public office in the State of Georgia, hereby
8	voluntarily endorse, subscribe to, and solemnly pledge myself to conduct my campaign in
9	accordance with the above principles and practices.

13	The Secretary of State shall print, or cause to be printed, blank forms of the Code of Fair
14	Campaign Practices. The Secretary of State shall supply the forms as necessary.

16	(a) The Secretary of State shall accept all completed forms submitted pursuant to this
17	article which are properly subscribed to by a candidate for public office.
18	(b) Each copy of the code pursuant to this article shall be preserved by the Secretary of
19	State for a period prescribed by the Secretary of State.

21	The subscription to the Code of Fair Campaign Practices by a candidate shall be voluntary.
22	21-5-97.
23	A candidate that has filed a copy of the Code of Fair Campaign Practices may so indicate
24	on political advertising in a form to be determined by the Secretary of State.

26	This article does not create a civil cause of action for recovery of damages or for
27	enforcement of this article."

29	All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
