BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

8 Code Section 50-3-100 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to English 9 designated as the official language, constitutional rights not denied, authorization for 10 documents and forms in other languages, and exceptions, is amended by revising subsection 11 (c) as follows:

"(c) State agencies, counties, municipal corporations, and political subdivisions of this
state are <u>not</u> authorized to use or to print official documents and forms in <u>languages any</u>
<u>language</u> other than the official language, at the discretion of their governing authorities.
Documents filed or recorded with a state agency or with the clerk of a county, municipal
corporation, or political subdivision must be in the official language or, if the original
document is in a language other than the official language, an English translation of the
