## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending James Avera Fisher; and for other purposes.

16 particularity the outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary individual.

18 the members of this body commend James Avera Fisher for his diligence and dedication in  
19 pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on  
20 attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
