A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 33-1-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 insurance fraud, venue, penalty, and exemption, so as to provide that issuing, with the intent
- 3 to defraud, any certificate of insurance which alters or represents any policy coverage,
- 4 exclusion, provision, or condition in any form other than actually contained in the policy
- 5 shall constitute a crime of insurance fraud; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Code Section 33-1-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to insurance fraud,
- 10 venue, penalty, and exemption, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 11 "(c.1) Any natural person who knowingly and willfully with intent to defraud issues any
- 12 certificate of insurance or other evidence of coverage which alters or purports to alter any
- policy coverage, exclusion, provision, or condition or represents that any policy coverage,
- exclusion, provision, or condition is applicable in any form other than that actually
- 15 contained in the policy commits the crime of insurance fraud."

SECTION 2.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
