## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Remembering and honoring the life of Dr. Robert Alan Lipson; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Robert Alan Lipson, M.D., was a gifted physician and a highly respected leader  
3 of the Georgia medical community; and
- 4 WHEREAS, after receiving his M.D. from Tulane University School of Medicine in 1971,  
5 Dr. Lipson honorably served his country as a physician and lieutenant in the U.S. Army; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Dr. Lipson put his training into the service of his fellow citizens, practicing  
7 medicine in Marietta, where he lived with his family since 1976; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Dr. Lipson became a committed champion for his community and for health  
9 care above and beyond his own medical practice, serving as a member of the Cobb County  
10 Medical Society, the Medical Association of Georgia, the American Medical Association,  
11 the Governing Council of the American Hospital Association, the Georgia State University  
12 Public Health Policy Committee, and on the Board of the Georgia Department of Community  
13 Health; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Dr. Lipson became President and CEO of WellStar Health System Physician  
15 Group in 2001, a not for profit system that he helped create and that continues to serve more  
16 than 1 million people in Cherokee, Cobb, Douglas, and Paulding counties; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Dr. Lipson was a devoted advocate of education and was instrumental in the  
18 development of the physician executive MBA program at Kennesaw State University, where  
19 he was a member of the advisory board for the executive MBA and nursing programs; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Dr. Lipson became an accomplished photographer whose work was the subject  
21 of public exhibition; and

1 WHEREAS, Dr. Lipson was a loving husband to Livvy, a proud father to Aaron and Rachel,  
2 and a doting grandfather to Karen; and

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia has lost one of its most dedicated and distinguished doctors  
4 and community leaders; and

5 WHEREAS, his vision, compassion, and charm can never be replaced.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
7 the members of this body join together to express their deepest regret at the passing of Dr.  
8 Robert Alan Lipson and extend their most sincere condolences to his family.
