- 1 Honoring and remembering the life of Mrs. Lillie B. Carson Reid; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Mrs. Lillie B. Carson Reid, a beloved mother to her community and a constant
3 rock of support for several generations of family and neighbors, answered her summons for
4 eternal rest on January 15, 2007; and
- 5 WHEREAS, she was born January 11, 1926, in Cordele, Georgia, to the late Jeff Carson and
6 Mary Lizzie Carson and was the stepdaughter of Mrs. Florence Carson; and
- 7 WHEREAS, she was united in holy matrimony to Jessie Reid, Sr., on May 11, 1946, and was
8 blessed with nine children: Jessie, Jr., Florence, Estella, Eleanor, Elizabeth, Samuel, Lillian,
9 Rosalyn, and Vivian; and

14 children a second mother, acting as a watchful chaperon and mentor; and
- 15 WHEREAS, she was a Poll Manager for many years and took it as a personal cause to
16 encourage active and responsible voting in her community; and
- 17 WHEREAS, in her spare time she enjoyed sewing, yard work, and travel; and
- 18 WHEREAS, while she was preceded in death by her husband, Jessie Reid, Sr., and children,
19 Jessie, Jr., Eleanor, and Samuel, she leaves to cherish her memory three siblings, six
20 children, 15 grandchildren, several great-grandchildren, and other loving relatives and
21 friends; and

1 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia has lost one of its most beloved citizens with the passing
2 of Mrs. Lillie B. Carson Reid.
