1 Commending musician and conservationist Chuck Leavell and inviting him to appear before
2 the House of Representatives; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Chuck Leavell is a member of the Alabama Music Hall of Fame and was
4 inducted into the Georgia Music Hall of Fame in 2004; and

5 WHEREAS, he has worked with such illustrious artists as The Rolling Stones, George
6 Harrison, Eric Clapton, the Allman Brothers Band, The Black Crowes, Train, and countless
7 others in the studio and on the road in addition to recording three solo albums; and

8 WHEREAS, Chuck is the noted author of an autobiography, Between Rock and a Home
9 Place; a children's book, The Tree Farmer; and a book on forestry and conservation, Forever
10 Green: The History and Hope of the American Forest; and

11 WHEREAS, Chuck and his wife, Rose Lane Leavell, are the owners of the award winning
12 Charlane Plantation, a celebrated tree farm and hunting lodge located just outside of Macon,
13 Georgia; and

14 WHEREAS, he is a two-time Georgia Tree Farmer of the Year and is a fantastic advocate
15 of environmental conservation and protection; and

16 WHEREAS, Chuck has been recently appointed by Governor Sonny Perdue to the "Land
17 Conservation Council."

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
19 the members of this body join in recognizing Chuck Leavell for his wonderful contributions
20 to the world of music and for his sustained devotion to environmental responsibility and the
