A RESOLUTION

1 Expressing congratulations and best wishes to Alice Sharpe Blount on the occasion of her
2 100th birthday; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Alice Sharpe Blount was born on February 7, 1907, as the ninth child of Charlie
4 and Mary Ann Collins Sharpe of Montgomery County, Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, she married Peter James Blount on October 23, 1923, and they had 11 children,
6 four girls and seven boys; and

7 WHEREAS, the family relocated to Toombs County in January of 1925, where they have
8 lived and farmed to this day; and

9 WHEREAS, Alice devoted herself wholeheartedly to her children, determined that every
10 member of her family would receive a thorough formal education, and six of her children and
11 more than 20 of her grandchildren and great-grandchildren have received at least an
12 undergraduate degree; and

13 WHEREAS, Alice is a devoted servant of the Lord and has been an active and loyal member
14 of Mount Calvary Baptist Church in Alston since 1925 and has served as Deaconess and
15 Mother of the Church; and

16 WHEREAS, Alice Sharpe Blount has been an adamant cornerstone of her family, an
17 indispensable member of her community, and a model Georgian.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body hereby
