The House Committee on Motor Vehicles offers the following substitute to HB 79:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Code Section 40-8-73.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
2	prohibition against affixing materials which reduce light transmission through windows or
3	windshields of motor vehicles, so as to provide exemptions for certain vehicles; to provide
4	for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
6	SECTION 1.
7	Code Section 40-8-73.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
8	prohibition against affixing materials which reduce light transmission through windows or
9	windshields of motor vehicles, is amended in subsection (c) by striking "or" at the end of
10	paragraph (6), striking the period at the end of paragraph (7) and inserting a semicolon in lieu
11	thereof, and adding new paragraphs to read as follows:

- under Code Section 40-2-61, 40-2-62, 40-2-63, or 40-2-64; 13
- 14 (9) Any vehicle owned or operated by the state or a political subdivision thereof and that
- displays a valid license plate issued pursuant to Code Section 40-2-37; or 15
- (10) Any vehicle operated in the course of business by a person licensed or registered 16
- 17 under Chapter 38 of Title 43, relating to private detective and private security businesses."
- 18 **SECTION 2.** 19 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 20 without such approval.

SECTION 3.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
