## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring and remembering the life of Dr. James Clarence Mosley, Jr.; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its most distinguished citizens with the passing  
4 of Dr. James Clarence Mosley, Jr., on January 28, 2007; and

5 WHEREAS, he was born February 14, 1951, in Indianapolis, Indiana, and graduated from  
6 Indiana Academy in Cicero, Indiana; and

7 WHEREAS, a highly motivated and intelligent young man, he attended Oakwood College  
8 in Huntsville, Alabama, where he received his Bachelor of Science in biology in 1973 and  
9 graduated from Northwestern College of Chiropractic in Bloomington, Minnesota, in 1984;  
10 and

11 WHEREAS, he founded Mosley Clinic of Chiropractic in Columbus, Georgia, in 1987,  
12 received his diploma in orthopaedics in 1993, and has seen thousands of patients in more  
13 than 20 years of practice; and

14 WHEREAS, he was the first African American chiropractor in Columbus, Georgia, and  
15 generously lent his wisdom, courage, and inspiring leadership ability above and beyond the  
16 call of his profession; and

17 WHEREAS, he leaves to cherish his memory a wife, Mrs. Bertha (Peggy) Mosley; a son, Dr.  
18 James Clarence Mosley III; two daughters, Sandria Marie Mosley and Dr. Sherri Lynette  
19 Mosley; his parents; two brothers; seven sisters; and a number of other relatives, godchildren,  
20 and extended family members; and

21 WHEREAS, in life he commanded the esteem of his fellow Georgians; at his death we  
22 mingle our sympathies with the grief of his family and friends.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
2 the members of this body join together to express their deepest regret at the passing of Dr.  
3 James Clarence Mosley, Jr., and extend their most sincere condolences to his family.
