## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending University System of Georgia Outstanding Scholar Madje M. Aniakou of  
2 Atlanta Metropolitan College on Academic Recognition Day for 2007; and for other  
3 purposes.

5 education to all and fostering the realization of each person's fullest potential; and
