## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Alesha Harris; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, approximately 300 students representing ten Georgia schools participated in the  
3 Third Annual Academic Competition at Andrew College in Cuthbert, Georgia, on January

5 WHEREAS, scholarships of up to \$3,000 were awarded to individual winners of competition  
6 sections for essay writing, mathematics, science, and social studies; and
