A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Joseph Garrett; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, approximately 300 students representing ten Georgia schools participated in the
3 Third Annual Academic Competition at Andrew College in Cuthbert, Georgia, on January
4 19, 2007; and
- 5 WHEREAS, scholarships of up to \$3,000 were awarded to individual winners of competition
6 sections for essay writing, mathematics, science, and social studies; and
- 7 WHEREAS, an outstanding team of students from Chattahoochee County High School gave
8 a sensational performance at the competition, scoring several first and second place awards
9 for individual competition as well as securing third place in the quiz bowl competition; and
- 10 WHEREAS, throughout their months of preparation and diligent study, this team of students
11 cheered and supported each other and demonstrated a positive attitude towards participating
12 in after-school meetings and completing practice material at home; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Joseph Garrett participated in the competition for eleventh grade mathematics,
14 and, in a spectacular display of concentration and mental prowess, claimed the title of second
15 place; and
- 16 WHEREAS, these young scholars have earned the respect of their peers and have brought
17 honor to their families, school, and community.

19 congratulate Joseph Garrett on winning second place in eleventh grade mathematics.
