14 Rucker Jones; four children; eight grandchildren; three brothers; one aunt; and a host of  
15 nieces, nephews, cousins, and other relatives and friends; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia has lost one of its most beloved citizens with the passing  
17 of Mr. Eddie Jones, Sr.
