A RESOLUTION

1 Dedicating the Paul Keenan Parkway; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Paul Keenan has contributed immensely to the quality of life enjoyed by the
3 citizens of Dougherty County and the City of Albany, Georgia, as a result of his
4 distinguished public service; and

5 WHEREAS, this successful businessman, attorney, and Albany native served his community
6 for 14 years as chairman of the board of commissioners of Dougherty County and four years
7 as mayor of the City of Albany; and

8 WHEREAS, throughout both periods of public service he was instrumental in improving
9 community relations, strengthening communication and cooperation between the city and the
10 county governmental authorities, and promoting local economic development; and

11 WHEREAS, his business expertise and legal knowledge have enabled him to offer valuable
12 leadership and well-reasoned solutions to various complex governmental and financial
13 problems; and

14 WHEREAS, Paul Keenan's leadership was instrumental in the construction of many highway
15 projects in the City of Albany and Dougherty County, including US 19, US 82, the Bypass,
16 Oakridge Drive, Dawson Road, Gillionville Road, and Westover Road; and

17 WHEREAS, his marriage to Lucile Dennison, a fellow law student at Emory University,
18 included rearing four accomplished children, and his public career and accomplishments
19 reflect the endorsement, admiration, and respect he has within his family and the community
20 at large.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
22 GEORGIA that the portion of SR 3 from the Mitchell/Dougherty county line (Mile Post 0)

1 north to the Dougherty/Lee county line (Mile Post 15.08), in Dougherty County, be dedicated
2 as the Paul Keenan Parkway, and that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
3 directed to place and maintain appropriate markers dedicating the Paul Keenan Parkway.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
5 to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to Paul Keenan and to the Department of
6 Transportation.
