- 3 WHEREAS, Private First Class Daniel Joseph Allman II was assigned to the 1st Battalion,
- 4 26th Infantry Regiment, 2nd Brigade Combat Team, 1st Infantry Division, Schweinfurt,
- 5 Germany, when he was tragically lost on November 13, 2006 to a roadside bomb in
- 6 Baghdad, Iraq; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he was a 2005 graduate of Franklin County High School, where he made an
- 8 impression on his principal, Diane Toney, who said that "Danny worked hard to fulfill his
- 9 dream of serving in the military"; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he was the proud father of a beautiful two-year-old daughter, Haleigh; and
- 11 WHEREAS, in addition to Haleigh, he leaves behind his mother Amanda Reese, his younger
- brother Michael, and his stepfather; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia, its citizens, and the members of this body have been
- 14 greatly moved and saddened at the passing of this courageous young man, and all Americans
- mourn his loss and honor the sacrifice he made to defend the liberty of this great nation.
- 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 17 join to remember and honor the life and sacrifice of Private First Class Daniel Joseph Allman
- 18 II, and extend their most heartfelt condolences to his family and friends.
