A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 43-8B-5 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the  
2 State Board of Cemeterians and the number, terms, appointments, vacancies, and removal  
3 of members, so as to change certain provisions relating to qualifications of board members;  
4 to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 43-8B-5 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the State Board  
8 of Cemeterians and the number, terms, appointments, vacancies, and removal of members,  
9 is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:

10 "(a) The board shall consist of six members who shall be practicing cemeterians with a  
11 minimum of five years of ~~registration as such in this state immediately preceding their~~  
12 ~~appointment~~ experience and one member who shall have no connection whatsoever with  
13 the cemetery profession but who shall have a recognized interest in consumer affairs and  
14 in consumer protection concerns."

15 **SECTION 2.**

16 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
17 without such approval.

18 **SECTION 3.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
