A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Jeremy Daniel Black on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on August 24, 2006, Jeremy Daniel Black of Boy Scout Troop 94 attained the
4 rank of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
7 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
8 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and

9 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and
10 Jeremy Daniel Black has ably demonstrated his aptitude and competency in mastering the
11 various special skills taught through the Boy Scout program; and

12 WHEREAS, this outstanding young man has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
13 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
14 becoming an Eagle Scout; and

15 WHEREAS, Jeremy's Eagle Scout service project involved reconstructing a floating dock
16 to be used to teach swimming classes during summer camp programs at the Wildlife Action
17 organization; and

18 WHEREAS, in a world which consistently seems to accentuate the negative aspects of the
19 actions of young people, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to recognize with
20 particularity the outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary individual.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
22 the members of this body commend Jeremy Daniel Black for his diligence and dedication in

1 pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on
2 attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
