- 1 Remembering and honoring the life of Dr. Robert Alan Lipson; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Robert Alan Lipson, M.D., was a gifted physician and a highly respected leader
- 3 of the Georgia medical community; and
- 4 WHEREAS, after receiving his Doctor of Medicine from Tulane University School of
- 5 Medicine in 1971, Dr. Lipson honorably served his country as a physician and lieutenant in
- 6 the U.S. Army; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Dr. Lipson put his training into the service of his fellow citizens, practicing
- 8 medicine in Marietta, where he lived with his family since 1976; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Dr. Lipson became a committed champion for his community and for health
- 10 care above and beyond his own medical practice, serving as a member of the Cobb County
- 11 Medical Society, the Medical Association of Georgia, the American Medical Association,
- 12 the Governing Council of the American Hospital Association, the Georgia State University
- 13 Public Health Policy Committee, and on the Board of the Georgia Department of Community
- 14 Health; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Dr. Lipson became President and CEO of WellStar Health System in 2001, a
- 16 not for profit system that he helped create and that continues to serve more than 1 million
- 17 people in Cherokee, Cobb, Douglas, and Paulding counties; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Dr. Lipson was instrumental in the development of the physician executive
- 19 Master of Business Administration program at Kennesaw State University, where he was one
- 20 of the program's first graduates and was a member of the advisory board for the executive
