## A RESOLUTION

- 2 WHEREAS, Blake Aaron Bell of Boy Scout Troop 298, has earned the rank of Eagle Scout  
3 which will be awarded to him in an Eagle Scout Court of Honor on March 25, 2007; and
- 4 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle has been the symbol of the highest achievement among  
5 the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the attainment of Eagle Scout rank indicates that a Scout has developed  
7 leadership ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities  
8 that will be of immense benefit throughout life; and

10 he possesses these qualities along with sterling character; and
- 11 WHEREAS, for a Scout to reach Eagle rank, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of which are  
12 mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and

14 to himself but also to his family and troop.
