## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 14A of Chapter 1 of Title 10 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to flea market vendors' record keeping, so as to restrict the sale of certain items at
- 3 flea markets; to provide for a misdemeanor; to provide for a fine; to repeal conflicting laws;
- 4 and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 14A of Chapter 1 of Title 10 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 flea market vendors' record keeping, is amended by revising the introductory language to
- 9 subsection (a) of Code Section 10-1-360, relating to definitions regarding flea markets, as
- 10 follows:
- 11 "(a) As used in this Code section article, the term:"
- 12 SECTION 2.
- 13 Said article is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 14 "10-1-363.
- 15 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'drug' shall have the same meaning as specified
- in Code Section 26-3-2.
- 17 (b) Neither food manufactured and packaged for sale for consumption by a child under the
- age of two years nor drugs shall be offered for sale or sold at a flea market. Any person
- violating the provisions of this Code section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable
- by a fine not greater than \$100.00 per item."
- SECTION 3.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
