

House Bill 475

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 14A of Chapter 1 of Title 10 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
2 relating to flea market vendors' record keeping, so as to restrict the sale of certain items at  
3 flea markets; to provide for a misdemeanor; to provide for a fine; to repeal conflicting laws;  
4 and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Article 14A of Chapter 1 of Title 10 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
8 flea market vendors' record keeping, is amended by revising the introductory language to  
9 subsection (a) of Code Section 10-1-360, relating to definitions regarding flea markets, as  
10 follows:

11 "(a) As used in this ~~Code section~~ article, the term:"

12 **SECTION 2.**

13 Said article is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

14 "10-1-363.

15 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'drug' shall have the same meaning as specified  
16 in Code Section 26-3-2.

17 (b) Neither food manufactured and packaged for sale for consumption by a child under the  
18 age of two years nor drugs shall be offered for sale or sold at a flea market. Any person  
19 violating the provisions of this Code section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable  
20 by a fine not greater than \$100.00 per item."

21 **SECTION 3.**

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
