A RESOLUTION

- 1 Dedicating the MIA/KIA Bryant H. Roberts, SFC Memorial Bridge; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Bryant H. Roberts, SFC was born on January 30, 1920, and served his country
- 3 in 1942, in the United States Navy aboard the U.S.S. Vincennes during World War II; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he made the ultimate sacrifice for his country in the name of freedom for all
- 5 Americans when he was lost at sea in the line of duty; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Berrien County deems it fitting and appropriate
- 7 to honor the service and sacrifice of Bryant H. Roberts by designating a permanent public
- 8 memorial near his homeplace.
- 9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 10 GEORGIA that the Ten Mile Creek Bridge on SR 168 near Nashville in Berrien County be
- 11 dedicated as the MIA/KIA Bryant H. Roberts, SFC Memorial Bridge and that the
- 12 Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to place and maintain appropriate
- 13 markers dedicating the MIA/KIA Bryant H. Roberts, SFC Memorial Bridge.
- 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 15 to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the family of Bryant H. Roberts and to the
- 16 Department of Transportation.
