A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act providing for the compensation of certain officials in Chatham County,  
2 approved March 26, 1986 (Ga. L. 1986, p. 4797), as amended by an Act approved April 21,  
3 1997 (Ga. L. 1997, p. 4446), so as to change the compensation of the judges of the recorder’s  
4 court, judge of the probate court, judges of the juvenile court, judges of the state court, and  
5 judges of the magistrate court; to remove cost-of-living increases; to provide an effective  
6 date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

9 An Act providing for the compensation of certain officials in Chatham County, approved  
10 March 26, 1986 (Ga. L. 1986, p. 4797), as amended by an Act approved April 21, 1997 (Ga.  
11 L. 1997, p. 4446), is amended by revising Section 1 as follows:

12 "SECTION 1.

13 (a) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, each officer and official of  
14 Chatham County listed in this subsection shall receive a salary fixed by the governing  
15 authority of such county, provided that said salary for each officer shall not be less than the  
16 salary set forth as follows:

17	Tax commissioner .....	\$53,000.00 per annum
18	Sheriff .....	54,000.00 per annum
19	Clerk of superior court .....	56,000.00 per annum
20	Clerk of the state court .....	45,000.00 per annum,
21		provided that if the
22		clerk of the state court
23		also serves as court
24		administrator, such

1 officer shall receive an  
 2 annual base salary to be  
 3 fixed by the governing  
 4 authority of the county  
 5 at not less than  
 6 \$60,000.00, payable in  
 7 equal monthly  
 8 installments from the  
 9 funds of the county.

10 Coroner ..... \$12,000.00 per annum

11 (b) Each officer and official of Chatham County listed in this subsection shall receive a  
 12 salary fixed by the governing authority of such county, provided that said salary for each  
 13 officer shall not be less than the salary set forth as follows:

14 Chief judge of the recorder’s court ..... An annual salary equal to the sum of 85  
 15 percent of the annual salary of a judge of  
 16 superior court as paid by the state plus 85  
 17 percent of the annual amount of any  
 18 supplement paid by the governing authority of  
 19 Chatham County to a judge of the superior  
 20 court, excluding any longevity pay to a judge  
 21 of the superior court pursuant to Ga. L. 1997,  
 22 p. 4108. In addition, the governing authority  
 23 of Chatham County shall pay to the chief  
 24 judge of the recorder’s court an additional  
 25 salary supplement as additional compensation  
 26 for performing the duties incumbent upon a  
 27 chief judge of not less than 85 percent of the  
 28 salary supplement paid to the chief judge of  
 29 the Eastern Judicial Circuit pursuant to Ga. L.  
 30 1997, p. 4108, Section 1(e).

31 Judge of the recorder’s court ..... An annual salary equal to the sum of 85  
 32 percent of the annual salary of a judge of  
 33 superior court as paid by the state plus 85  
 34 percent of the annual amount of any  
 35 supplement paid by the governing authority of  
 36 Chatham County to a judge of the superior

1 court, excluding any longevity pay to a judge  
 2 of the superior court pursuant to Ga. L. 1997,  
 3 p. 4108.

4 Judge of the probate court . . . . . An annual salary equal to the sum of 80  
 5 percent of the annual salary of a judge of  
 6 superior court as paid by the state plus 80  
 7 percent of the annual amount of any  
 8 supplement paid by the governing authority of  
 9 Chatham County to a judge of the superior  
 10 court, excluding any longevity pay to a judge  
 11 of the superior court pursuant to Ga. L. 1997,  
 12 p. 4108.

13 Presiding judge of the juvenile court . . . . . An annual salary equal to the sum of 90  
 14 percent of the annual salary of a judge of  
 15 superior court as paid by the state plus 90  
 16 percent of the annual amount of any  
 17 supplement paid by the governing authority of  
 18 Chatham County to a judge of the superior  
 19 court, excluding any longevity pay to a judge  
 20 of the superior court pursuant to Ga. L. 1997,  
 21 p. 4108. In addition, the governing authority  
 22 of Chatham County shall pay to the presiding  
 23 judge of the juvenile court an additional salary  
 24 supplement as additional compensation for  
 25 performing the duties incumbent upon a  
 26 presiding judge of not less than 90 percent of  
 27 the salary supplement paid to the chief judge  
 28 of the Eastern Judicial Circuit pursuant to Ga.  
 29 L. 1997, p. 4108, Section 1(e).

30 Judge of the juvenile court . . . . . An annual salary equal to the sum of 90  
 31 percent of the annual salary of a judge of  
 32 superior court as paid by the state plus 90  
 33 percent of the annual amount of any  
 34 supplement paid by the governing authority of  
 35 Chatham County to a judge of the superior  
 36 court, excluding any longevity pay to a judge

Chief judge of the state court . . . . . An annual salary equal to the sum of 95 percent of the annual salary of a judge of superior court as paid by the state plus 95 percent of the annual amount of any supplement paid by the governing authority of Chatham County to a judge of the superior court, excluding any longevity pay to a judge of the superior court pursuant to Ga. L. 1997, p. 4108. In addition, the governing authority of Chatham County shall pay to the chief judge of the state court an additional salary supplement as additional compensation for performing the duties incumbent upon a chief judge of not less than 95 percent of the salary supplement paid to the chief judge of the Eastern Judicial Circuit pursuant to Ga. L. 1997, p. 4108, Section 1(e).

Judge of the state court . . . . . An annual salary equal to the sum of 95 percent of the annual salary of a judge of superior court as paid by the state plus 95 percent of the annual amount of any supplement paid by the governing authority of Chatham County to a judge of the superior court, excluding any longevity pay to a judge of the superior court pursuant to Ga. L. 1997, p. 4108.

Chief magistrate of the magistrate court . . . . . An annual salary equal to the sum of 80 percent of the annual salary of a judge of superior court as paid by the state plus 80 percent of the annual amount of any supplement paid by the governing authority of Chatham County to a judge of the superior court, excluding any longevity pay to a judge of the superior court pursuant to Ga. L. 1997,

1 p. 4108. In addition, the governing authority  
 2 of Chatham County shall pay to the chief  
 3 magistrate of the magistrate court an  
 4 additional salary supplement as additional  
 5 compensation for performing the duties  
 6 incumbent upon a chief judge of not less than  
 7 80 percent of the salary supplement paid to  
 8 the chief judge of the Eastern Judicial Circuit  
 9 pursuant to Ga. L. 1997, p. 4108, Section 1(e).

10 Magistrates of the magistrate court . . . . . An annual salary equal to the sum of 80  
 11 percent of the annual salary of a judge of  
 12 superior court as paid by the state plus 80  
 13 percent of the annual amount of any  
 14 supplement paid by the governing authority of  
 15 Chatham County to a judge of the superior  
 16 court, excluding any longevity pay to a judge  
 17 of the superior court pursuant to Ga. L. 1997,  
 18 p. 4108.

19 (c) The governing authority of Chatham County shall grant each officer and official listed  
 20 in subsection (a) of this section the same percentage increases in salary that it grants as  
 21 cost-of-living increases to employees of Chatham County. Such increases shall be granted  
 22 at the same time cost-of-living increases are granted to county employees."

## 23 SECTION 2.

24 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
 25 without such approval.

## 26 SECTION 3.

27 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
