

Senate Resolution 326

### A RESOLUTION

1 Urging the United States Congress to reform U.S. sugar policy; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the manufacturers of foods and beverages that contain sugar are extremely  
3 important to the economy of the State of Georgia, providing thousands of jobs and millions  
4 of dollars of annual economic impact; and

5 WHEREAS, current U.S. sugar policy will be subject to greater scrutiny during  
6 Congressional consideration of the 2007 Farm Bill; and

7 WHEREAS, the future U.S. sugar policy should be based on greater transparency and market  
8 orientation; and

9 WHEREAS, ethanol derived from sugarcane, sugar beet, and corn production in America  
10 holds promise for helping to meet our national goals of reducing our nation's dependence on  
11 foreign oil; and

12 WHEREAS, incorporating production safety nets for farm families that cultivate these  
13 traditional food crops will prove more beneficial if resources are directed to energy  
14 production.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
16 urge members of the Georgia congressional delegation to work together to bring the type of  
17 reasonable reform to U.S. sugar policy that will in turn stabilize our foreign trade and  
18 domestic economic policies.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
20 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to each member of Georgia's congressional  
21 delegation.
