- 1 Commending Georgia's emergency medical services professionals and recognizing
- 2 Emergency Medical Services Week; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, through a coordinated, state-wide network, the emergency medical services
- 4 professionals of Georgia respond to almost one million calls for assistance annually, risking
- 5 their lives on a daily basis to go to the aid of those in need; and
- 6 WHEREAS, there are well over 15,000 emergency medical personnel in this state; and
- 7 WHEREAS, their dedication gives Georgians peace of mind in knowing that, should the
- 8 need arise, there will be a well-trained and compassionate emergency medical services
- 9 professional available to render swift and effective assistance; and
- 10 WHEREAS, access to quality emergency care dramatically improves the survival and
- 11 recovery rate of persons stricken with sudden illness or injury; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Georgia's emergency medical services system is celebrating its thirty-fourth
- 13 year of service in 2007.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body commends
- 15 Georgia's first responders, emergency medical technicians, cardiac technicians, and
- paramedics for their outstanding service to the people of this state and recognizes May 20
- 17 through May 26, 2007, as Emergency Medical Services Week.
- 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 19 to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to Courtney Terwilliger, President of the
- 20 Georgia Association of Emergency Medical Services, and Marty Billings, Director of the
- 21 Georgia Office of Emergency Medical Services of the Department of Human Resources,
- 22 Division of Public Health.
