A RESOLUTION

1 Relative to adjournment; and for other purposes.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that, unless otherwise
 3 provided by subsequent resolution of the General Assembly, the meeting dates and dates of
 4 adjournment for the 2007 regular session of the General Assembly for the period of March
 5 1, 2007, through April 17, 2007, shall be as follows:

6 Thursday, March 1 in session for legislative day 27
 7 Friday March 2, through Sunday, March 18 in adjournment
 8 Monday, March 19 in session for legislative day 28
 9 Tuesday, March 20 in session for legislative day 29
 10 Wednesday, March 21 through Monday, March 26 . . in adjournment
 11 Tuesday, March 27 in session for legislative day 30
 12 Wednesday, March 28 in session for legislative day 31
 13 Thursday, March 29 in session for legislative day 32
 14 Friday March 30 in session for legislative day 33
 15 Saturday, March 31 through Monday, April 9 in adjournment
 16 Tuesday, April 10 in session for legislative day 34
 17 Wednesday, April 11 in session for legislative day 35
 18 Thursday, April 12 in session for legislative day 36
 19 Friday, April 13 through Monday, April 16 in adjournment
 20 Tuesday, April 17 in session for legislative day 37

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on and after April 17, 2007, the periods of adjournment
 22 of the 2007 session, if any, shall be as specified by subsequent resolution of the General
 23 Assembly, except that for the remainder of the 2007 regular session, unless otherwise
 24 provided by subsequent resolution, the General Assembly shall adjourn at the close of the
 25 legislative day on each Friday on which the General Assembly is in session and shall
 26 reconvene on the following Monday.

- 1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as authorized by Code Section 28-1-2, the hours for
- 2 closing and convening the Senate on each day may be as ordered by the Senate; and the
- 3 hours for closing and convening the House on each day may be as ordered by the House.
