3 School; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Reverend White enlisted in the United States Army in 1969 and after a two-year
5 tour of duty continued his service in the Army National Guard from 1977-1983; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Reverend White worked as a Fulton County Sheriff's Deputy from 1979 until
7 he retired in 2003; and
- 8 WHEREAS, in 1998, Reverend White graduated magna cum laude from Beulah Heights
9 Bible College and completed his Master of Divinity at the Gammon Theological Seminary
10 in 2002; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Reverend White has touched congregations throughout the State of Georgia,
12 and he currently serves as pastor to Clarkston United Methodist Church in Clarkston,
13 Georgia; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Reverend White has served his country, his state, and his community for almost
15 40 years as a soldier, a law enforcement officer, and a man of the cloth; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Reverend White has been blessed with a marriage of 20 years to his wife,
17 Valerie, and is father to a son, Reginald, and two daughters, Brittney and Courtney.
