## A RESOLUTION

18 class of 2007 have never lost a GISA cross country competition, and as members of the  
19 varsity team, they have been undefeated from the beginning of the 2002 season through the

22 dedication, and hard work of each team member and of the astute direction of the five time  
23 GISA AAA Boys State Coach of the Year, Chad McDaniel.
