## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Greenfield Hebrew Academy; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Greenfield Hebrew Academy has established and maintained a proud tradition  
3 of excellence in education since its founding in 1953; and

4 WHEREAS, this outstanding academy has set the standard for Jewish education in Atlanta  
5 and throughout the State of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, Greenfield Hebrew Academy is the oldest Jewish day school in Atlanta and the  
7 first day school in the country to be accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and  
8 Schools; and

9 WHEREAS, this prestigious institution has twice been honored as a National School of  
10 Excellence by the Council for American Private Education; and

11 WHEREAS, since its inception, the Greenfield Hebrew Academy has provided students with  
12 an outstanding day school education, integrating Judaic and general studies in a traditional  
13 curriculum that is both challenging and stimulating; and

14 WHEREAS, the Greenfield Hebrew Academy community includes the broadest possible  
15 spectrum of Atlanta's Jewish community and is united by the shared values of the Jewish  
16 people, including the unity of the Jewish people (klal yisrael), belief in God (emunah), moral  
17 and ethical behavior (derech erez), and making the world a better place (tikkun olam); and

18 WHEREAS, Greenfield Hebrew Academy cultivates each student's distinctive talents,  
19 making sure to inform the mind, develop the body, and enlighten the spirit; its experienced  
20 faculty helps to guide children on their journey towards maturity and intellectual growth; and  
21 its graduates succeed at Atlanta's finest high schools and the most esteemed universities and  
22 yeshivot.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
2 recognize Greenfield Hebrew Academy and commend its outstanding dedication and  
3 commitment to excellence in education.
